1. SUMMARY

In 2024 Amica Educa realized total of **1.265 days of different activities** and services which included 1.699 persons (children, youth and adults) of whom majority came from the Tuzla City region and other towns/cities in Tuzla Canton.

As an organizer or co-organizer Amica Educa conducted **3 public events** and campaigns which additionally included around **1000 citizens**.

Informational – educational campaign on social media and published posts (total of **121 posts**) reached **1.143.157 persons from entire Bosnia and Herzegovina.**

Amica Educa promoted its work and informed public about important topics via 52 public appearances in local, federal or state TV and radio programs as well as web portals from entire BiH.

1. PSYCHO-EDUCATIVE WORKSHOPS FOR PERSONS IN THE STATE OF PSYCHO-SOCIAL NEED AND EXPERTS IN HELPING OCCUPATIONS



Description / Target group: Persons in the state of psycho-social need through participation in psychoeducative workshops improve their mental and social health, adopt knowledge and skills which serve to improve personal functioning in different contexts, easier handling of life challenges and application of healthy patterns of behavior which significantly improve life quality. Experts in helping occupations adopt and improve knowledge and skills that they use in their work with their clients and beneficiaries and prevent/reduce professional burn-out.

2. PROJECT PEERS AS CHANGE AGENTS

Description / Target group:

Educated youth (16 to 28 years old) from Tuzla Canton who with their engagement and activism promote importance of youth mental health and gender equality and provide support to youth through peer counseling.

Implemented activities:

- Gender based Violence in Youth Partner Relationships
- · Peer Counseling



Project volunteers' engagements:

• 12 volunteers implemented 7 info sessions on youth mental health and/or gender-based violence in Banovici, Miricina, Lukavac, Kalesija, Zivinice, Gracanica and Tuzla which included 104 young people.



- 9 volunteers provided peer to peer counseling, both online and in person for total of 40 young people.
- 20 volunteers conducted Street campaign on Youth Mental Health which was visited by 250 citizens of Tuzla Canton.
- 12 volunteers created total 121 social media posts on youth mental health and GBV which reached 1.143.457 people from entire BiH

3. PROJECT: EMPOWERMENT OF YOUNG WOMEN -**BEGINNING OF A CHANGE**

Description / Target group:

Unemployed young women (15 to 35 years old) from TK are receiving support through education, coaching and psychotherapy aimed at personal and professional empowerment, improvement of their employability and socioeconomic integration. The first project year (three year project started in July 2023) has been successfully completed.

Number of beneficiaries and activities:

4. GENDER EQUALITY PROGRAM

1. PROJECT BREAKING THE SILENCE ON GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

Description / Target group: School children and teachers in elementary and high schools adopt knowledge which serves to prevent gender-based violence (GBV) through informing and educating on social values which support equal rights and respect for all members of community regardless of their gender.



From January to July 2024 project was implemented in Elementary School Slavinovici and from July to December 2024 in two local high schools, Gimnazija Ismet Mujezinovic (preparation for University education) and Turističko-Ugostiteljska škola (vocational type education).

Description / Target group:

Through personal and socioeconomic empowerment of unemployed women, it helps solving problem of the lower rate of employment among women and reducing of the gender inequalities in the labor market.

5. OTHER PROJECTS

1. PROJECT: PROFESSIONALIZATION OF ADULT EDUCATION CENTERS IN EUROPE



Description / Target group:

The project aims at development of capacities in the field of adult education, development of adult education programs, networking with members of the European Association for Adult Education (EAEA), and supporting organizational development through cooperation with German high schools. Implemented in period 2022 – 2024 (eight months every year from March to October).

Implemented activities:

• Cooperated with VHS Cham (partner organization form Germany) on capacity building of Amica Educa in the area of quality management: New tool was developed: Evaluation of trainers existing tool was improved: Evaluation of the training by training participants.

These tools will be used as regular

procedure in Amica Educa.

- Developed holistic curriculum for nonformal adult education program.
- Participated in organization and presented in Symposium: Investing in Adult Education: Grounds for successful society, participated in International Conference "Adult Education in the European Education Area: Perspectives from Southeast Europe", and in online regional conference.
- Partner meeting was held in December, serving as evaluation of achieved results and closing of the project.

2. PROJECT: INCLUSION AND DIVERSITY IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

Description / Target group: The project aims to promote integration and diversity in involved in education of preschool children by improving the knowledge and skills of experts (on topics: culture, gender identity and sexual orientation, trauma) so that they can adequately respond to the challenges of social trends. The project lasts 25 months (October 1, 2023 - October 31, 2025) and includes the partnership of 7 institutions/organizations from Germany, Spain, Poland, Italy and Bosnia and Herzegovina.



Implemented activities:

• As a project partner, Amica Educa contributed to the development of learning outcomes for training on the topic of Trauma, and to the development of tools for self-assessment of professionals, i.e. their knowledge, skills and attitudes on three topics: culture, gender

identity and sexual orientation, trauma.

- Amica Educa is the leading partner for Work Package 3, which includes the creation of a curriculum for the training of experts in the field of preschool education and training materials. The documents were created in cooperation with project partners.
- 25 experts (five from each partner country) conducted an expert analysis of the first draft of the curriculum for the training of experts and related materials for training preparation, which resulted in positive feedback.
- Partner meetings were held in Germany and Italy where current and future activities within the work packages of the project were discussed.

3. PROJECT: MENTAL WELLBEING IN EDUCATION FOR DISADVANTEG YOUTH (MEET)

Description / Target group: The project aims to build capacities for the promotion of youth mental health in formal and informal education and training through the development of inclusive and innovative tools and materials for educators, social workers and youth at risk, and through the integration of youth mental health programs and guidelines into educational policies. The project is implemented by a consortium of 15 partners from 11 countries. The duration of the project is from January 1, 2024 to June 30, 2026.

Implemented activities:

- Established project management: activity planning, task allocation, monitoring and financial monitoring, analysis of program procedures and documents
- 3 examples of good practice in the field of mental health of young people were developed and integrated into the State Report that was used to create the document Catalogue of Good Practices Aimed at Young People.
- •Contribution to the development of the Laboratory for Youth Mental Health Methodology, which together



with the Catalog of Good Practices Aimed at Young People presents the results of this project, which will be available to the public.

- Organized and implemented workshop Laboratory for Mental Health of Young People" in Tuzla (in accordance with the developed Methodology), which was preceded by mapping and informing relevant actors in the field of mental health of young people, and analysis of available documents on mental health of young people in BiH and the region.
- The panelist at the 2nd webinar on mental health of young people organized as part of the project was a representative of Amica Educe

- who presented her experiences in working on the psycho-social empowerment of young women.
- Contribution to the development of inclusive learning tools for youth mental health such as: a transnational framework for youth mental health, a digital game for a transnational campaign and preliminary versions of Toolbox for practitioners and learning materials for youth.
- Participation in partner meetings in Vienna, Austria and Rešice, Romania.

Amica Educa established new and continued a number of existing collaborations with government institutions, public institutions, international and local non-governmental organizations.

 – 2024, Amica Educa participated
 in the writing of the report for the
 2023 which was presented and
 the accepted at the Assembly of
 the Government of TK
- Amica Educa was appointed to the Working Group for the implementation and monitoring of the Gender Action Plan of the City of Tuzla for the period 2024-2027 (GAP).



- Amica Educa took part in the education organized by the OSCE and Tuzla Canton Commission for Gender Equality organized for members of the Coordination Committee for Implementation and Monitoring of the Gender Action Plan (GAP) in Tuzla Canton on the topic of Gender Sensitive Budgeting.
- Amica Educa took part in a meeting organized by BIH Federation Center for members of the Coordination Committee for Implementation and Monitoring of the Gender Action Plan (GAP) in Tuzla Canton to discuss current issues, upcoming final report for the 2021-2024 period and to plan creation of the GAP TK for 2024-2027.
- Amica Educa was recognized as an organization with innovative approaches and valuable experience in working with young people by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Tuzla Canton and the University of Tuzla, and was invited to contribute to the creation of a publication entitled Book of good ideas - building peace and nonviolence. For this publication,



Amica Educa presented the achieved results in work with young people, focusing specifically on the Youth Agents as Social Changemakers project.

· The Ministry of Labor, Social Affairs and Return of Tuzla Canton requested the filling out of a form with the aim of collecting and unifying data on social services providers in BiH Federation and which contains basic information about service providers, a description of activities and individual services provided within institutions/ associations, categories and the number of beneficiaries to whom the services can be provided, and information on the cost of those services. Data will be used for the alignment with the preliminary draft of the Law on Social Services, which the Cantonal Ministry od Labor, Social Affairs and Return of TK will submit to

- the Federal Ministry for further processing.
- Finalization of the Action Plan for prevention and fight against domestic violence for the period 2024 - 2025 workshop. The workshop was organized by the Coordinating Team for Prevention and Combating Domestic Violence in TK, with the support of the OSCE Mission to BiH, the regional office in Tuzla and the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina Gender Center. Representatives of relevant institutions and nongovernmental organizations, including a representative of Amica Educa gave their contribution during this workshop.
- Amica Educa and Ministry
 of Education and Science of
 Tuzla Canton are partners on
 MEET Project (INTERREG EU
 Program for Danube region),
 while Ministry of Economy of
 Tuzla Canton is joined strategic
 partner. This results in close
 communication and cooperation
 with these Ministries on topics
 related to mental health of youth
 in their respective fields and
 within project activities.
- Within MEET project and implementation of activity Youth Mental Health Lab, Amica Educa targeted stakeholders from governmental bodies, alongside other relevant actors, and through this activity enabled dialog and cooperation on topic of youth mental health. The event included representatives of cantonal ministries: Ministry of Health TK, Ministry of Culture, Sports and Youth TK, Ministry of Labor, Social Affairs and Return TK. as well as representatives of institutions such as: Center for Social Work, Pedagogical Institute of Tuzla Canton, City of Tuzla, University of Tuzla, Disciplinary Center of Tuzla Canton and Home for Children Without Parental Care and high school representatives.



2. COOPERATION WITH PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS

- A lecture/workshop Art therapy for 15 students (15F) of Psychology, University of Tuzla. Workshop was held in the premises of Amica Educa. During this lecture/workshop, in addition to practical knowledge, students had the opportunity to learn about Amica Educa programs and projects aimed at young people with a focus on mental health and gender equality.
- Several meeting were held with the representatives of Pedagogical Institute Tuzla to ensure easier coordination and application for approvals for projects implemented in schools

- Upon completion of the project cooperation with Elementary School Slavinovici was finished and new cooperation with two high schools was established for new school year (2024/2025) Gymnasium Ismet Mujezinovic and Tourist High School.
- With the aim of presenting activities in the INDEAR project, Amica Educa held meetings with relevant stakeholders: University of Tuzla Education and rehabilitation Faculty, Pedagogical Institute of Tuzla Canton, Public Institution Nase Dijete (public kindergartens).



3. COOPERATION WITH INTERNATIONAL AND LOCAL NON-GOVERNMENTAL INSTITUTIONS

- NERDA Development Association and Amica Educa signed Memorandum of Understanding, for the purpose of planning and implementing joint activities with the aim of improving the psychosocial and socioeconomic status of citizens and continuously strengthening the capacity of local communities in the field of psychosocial work, nonformal education and socioeconomic empowerment.
- Within MEET project and implementation of activity Youth Mental Health Lab, Amica Educa contacted and included relevant local NGO's: Foundation of Tuzla Community, Association Land of Children in B&H, Informative Center for Disabled Persons Lotos, NERDA- Development Association.



- MEET and INDEAR projects have widened the scope of international organizations Amica Educa cooperates with. This also opens opportunities for cooperation in the future, and exchange of experiences and information.
- On the March 8 Amica Educa along with other organizations organized a performance named "Am I next?! in Tuzla. Citizens of Tuzla took part in performance which served to shown existing

inequalities that women in BiH still suffer from and to pay respect to generations of women before who fought for our rights.





- As part of the marking of the "16 days of activism against gender-based violence" on 10 December of 2024 non-governmental organizations, activists, citizens of the Tuzla Canton, and for the purpose of pointing out the social problem of violence against women in BiH, we gathered in the city center near the monument "Ismet and Meša" and distributed leaflets and information about abusers.
- Within the project Peers as Change Agents cooperation with youth organization Trik from Kalesija, Baum from Banovici, Young Man Initiative from Gracanica, Youth Bank from Zivinice and BH Medical Student Association.
- · Symposium Investing in Adult Education: Foundation for a Successful Society was organized by DVV International - Office for Bosnia and Herzegovina in cooperation with partners: CEI NAHLA. Center for the Promotion of Civil Society (CPCD), Association for Local Development Initiatives ALDI and Association Amica Educa. This event provided an opportunity for an open discussion about the challenges, opportunities and necessary steps for the development of adult education in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

4. PARTICIPATION IN MEETINGS, CONFERENCES, EDUCATIONS AND PUBLIC EVENTS

• International Conference Adult Education in the European Education Area: Perspectives from Southeast Europe with speakers from Germany, Croatia, Serbia, Slovenia, North Macedonia, and Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Amica Educa representative participated in lectures, panel discussions, and took part in thematic sessions that highlighted the key challenges and perspectives of adult education in the European education area, with a special focus on Southeast Europe.





 Kvirhana Festival organized by Tuzla Open Centre – Amica Educa participated in this years activities which are financed by the USAID. Participated in training on the Integrated Security Workshop organized by Foundation Cure for representatives of feminist and women's rights organizations.
 Topics discussed were personal, organizational security and well being.



• Panel discussion: (Re)choice of Profession: Opportunities, examples and support organized by the Educational Center Nahla Tuzla, within the Meet Up. The panel discussion opened the topic of career re-choice as an insufficiently explored option for unemployed women, employed women who want to improve their status and women who want to start their own business, all with the aim of economically empowering women in our society.
